You make your own air arrangements to Scotland – allowing you the freedom of going early or staying longer. We suggest you fly to Scotland on (Friday, July 29th– see Page 4).

Sunday, July 31: Gather in the Edinburgh Airport's International Arrival Area no later than 8:45am and meet Charlie, Tad and the Reids. We'll hop onto our luxury Telford Coach and set out for Dundee, making a couple of stops along the way as we travel north. First, The Royal Burgh of Culross. Next – a marvel of the world – The Falkirk Wheel. Then the Kelpies - 110 feet tall and the most magnificent equine sculptures anywhere. Tonight, we'll have our **first** of **six planned dinners** after checking into our home for the next four nights - the Queen's Hotel in Dundee.

Monday, August 1: A great day today! After our Scottish breakfast we have a date with history! We're spending the day in St. Andrews. You'll be set free to wander the grounds of the magnificent Cathedral, explore the Castle and the adjoining museum, peruse the shops, check the University grounds, have a tasty lunch. And don't forget to get your pictures on the Old Course! It's the home of Golf! Back to the hotel and after dinner, **our first Charlie & Tad Show!!!!**

Tuesday, August 2: After a huge breakfast we drive north along the coastal road. Our destination is the incredible Dunnottar Castle. This is a photo stop but the views are incredible!!! It has been besieged by Vikings, captured by William Wallace, secretly guarded the Crown Jewels of Scotland. Brechin Cathedral is worthy of a stop and then on to Arbroath Abbey. Here the Declaration of Arbroath was written in 1320 – proclaiming the right of Scotland to be its own free country. That document inspired Thomas Jefferson and our Founding Fathers to write our Declaration of Independence. After dinner – more music with Charlie and Tad!

Wednesday, August 3: A leisurely morning follows another "too much" breakfast! Dundee is yours to explore. We'll have a list of things to do. After lunch, we'll meet and go to Royal Falkland Palace and its beautiful gardens. Charlie will tell us of the Palace connections to the House of Stewart. Tonight – back to the hotel for a relaxing night. Pack your bags as we leave for Edinburgh in the morning.

Thursday, August 4: Today we head for the Kingdom of Fife and the coastal villages along the North Sea. Here are the most charming little towns of Anstruther, Crail and Pittenweem and more await us. In Pittenweem, we'll see if the Chocolate Cafe will give us the key to St. Fillan's cave. The 7th Century Irish monk with the "glowing arm" was renown as a healer and the water in the cave are said to be restorative... From Fife, we drive across the new Firth of Forth Bridge to our hotel for the next three nights – The Holiday Inn. **Tonight, Charlie and Tad entertain us!**

Friday, August 5: This morning we are heading to the huge Tantallon Castle in East Lothian. This is a wonder in all respects. The 14th century fortress overlooks Bass Rock and is the last of the Scottish Curtin Walled Castles. Red in color – it reeks of history, murder, intrigue and battles. On the way back to Edinburgh, we'll visit the Battlefield of Prestonpans, where the Jacobite army outfought the Government forces on September 21, 1745. I'm sure Charlie will give us a song or two. We'll be back at the hotel in the early afternoon and take our coach into town, set you free to explore, find on your own dinner and meet us at the Castle at 7:30 to see the most incredible musical show with hundreds of pipers, drummers, Highland Dancers, and performers from around the world! **THE EDINBURGH MILITARY TATTOO!**

Saturday, August 6: Our last day and tons to do! It's just a fifteen-minute ride into Princes Street on the tram or by bus right outside of the hotel for all the wonders of Princes Street, the Gardens, The Royal Mile and of course the Castle and so much more 'cause it's Festival time. Shopping, exploring, eating, maybe a drink at "The Last Drop" or "Jinglin' Geordie". Explore Mary King's Close, the Underground City, museums, or a climb up the Walter Scott Monument, have a chance to see where Harry Potter was written... or... the world-famous Edinburgh Zoo is right next to the hotel... Make your way back to the hotel for dinner at 6:30pm and **our last night of music with Charlie & Tad.**

Sunday, August 7: Well, all things come to an end. We board our coach and head for the Edinburgh Airport where we say Cheerio. You'll head back with tales and stories, memories and laughs to tell your friends of how we explored Scotland's beautiful countryside and enjoyed the music of Charlie and his fiddler friend, Tad. HERE ARE ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS YOU MIGHT HAVE!

The tour does not include airfare. You are free to make your own travel arrangements – allowing you to go over before or stay longer than the tour or to arrive the day the tour begins and go home the day the tour ends.

<u>When should we be at Edinburgh Airport?</u> You must be in the international arrivals area of the Edinburgh Airport no later than 8:45am on Sunday, July 31, 2022.

<u>Will I need a passport?</u> Yes – to travel internationally a valid passport is needed by all passengers. If you do not have one, please apply for it so that you have it in hand by January 1, 2022. Make sure it is valid through November, 2022.

<u>What about luggage?</u> Most airlines allow each passenger one standard piece of luggage up to 50 lbs in weight to go into the hold and one carry-on. After that, it'll cost you extra – and honestly, you won't need more than one case going over – it's the return when you are loaded down with presents for your friends and family members that will be "fun"! So, keep it to one suitcase per person!

<u>What should we pack?</u> More on this as we get closer to August but Scotland is typically a month or two behind the states so figure on East Coast June weather. Layers are the best to fend off the chill and wind and of course it will rain - so a rain proof jacket is handy. We are a very "relaxed" group so be casually comfortable. And don't worry – there are stores that will be happy to take care of your needs. Don't forget your camera!

<u>What happens when we arrive at Edinburgh's Airport?</u> We'll gather our bags and head out on our Telford coach. If you haven't done this at home, visit the ATM and the convenient bank at the airport to exchange some dollars for pounds and pence. Later on, we'll cover the money issues and make suggestions. You can use your credit card but call your card company ahead of time to let them know you will be using it in Scotland.

<u>Cell phones (they are called mobile phones in Scotland)?</u> We suggest you call your phone carrier and explore an international plan. Several offer a per day and per use deal.

Is there free WiFi? Our hotels should have free WiFi but check when we get there. And make sure you are on it!!

How many hotels will we be staying in? 4 nights in Dundee and 3 nights in Edinburgh.

What about meals? Every morning you will be amazed at the breakfast. They are all included. The tour details lists the (6) dinners planned and are included in the tour price. You are responsible for one dinner in Edinburgh. You will have to take care of your lunches. But don't worry – we have plans to make sure everyone is fed and happy. By the way, if you don't force me to eat brussel sprouts – i won't force you to eat blood pudding or haggis! Well I will badger you until you do – and you'll be happy I did!

How many are going on the trip? Tour will be limited to one coach and the tour can have up to 50 people plus Charlie, Tad, Karen & Bill.

Will Charlie & Tad be with us? Yes! Throughout the trip, at the hotels and exploring the nooks and crannies of Scotland.

Will there be time to shop? Of course! You will have ample opportunities to shop 'til you drop!

Will there be music? Hey – we're with Charlie Zahm!! We've four nights of music planned just for our group.

Will there be beverages available? In Scotland?? Are you kidding? Lots of beers, gin & whisky! Soda and lime, colas, etc.

<u>What should I remember?</u> Start practicing looking the other way when you cross the street. Remember, french fries are chips, a potato chip is a crisp, the hood of a car is the bonnet (see what you should be practicing – so you don't meet one of these!).

Failure to purchase airfare will result in cancellation of your tour with no refunds. If you experience arrival flight delay, you must contact us (contact information will be provided)

You are not limited any particular airline but must meet the group at the arrival area of Edinburgh Airport no later than 8:45am on July 31st.
